

CV of Georgios Kosyvas

Georgios Kosyvas studied Mathematics at the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki and continued with postgraduate studies in Teaching and Methodology of Mathematics at the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens and in Organization and Administration of Education at the Université Libre de Bruxelles (ULB). Having obtained a scholarship from State Scholarships Foundation, he completed his doctoral dissertation and in 2001 he was declared Doctor of Pedagogy of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. Furthermore, with a second scholarship from State Scholarships Foundation he conducted post-doctoral research in the area of Mathematics Education. He speaks English and French.

He has taught at all levels of education (primary, secondary and tertiary). He taught at universities and at teacher training and post graduate teacher training programmes. As part of his educational experience in recent years he taught in pilot high schools (high schools following pilot programmes) for seven years and in the European School of Brussels III for five years.

His publications include articles in national and international journals, papers in scientific conferences and books. Among other things he has written 10 books and more than 50 published works. He is engaged in the Teaching of Mathematics, teacher training and the wider Education for children and adults.

From January 2012 to September 2015 he worked as Educational Advisor of Mathematics in Athens. Since September 2015 he has been working as a counsellor at the Education Office of the Greek Embassy in London.
